The 1452 foot (443m) long wrought iron viaduct was constructed in 1877 and is now a grade II list building.

GNA was delighted to be involved in works to preserve this historic Nottinghamshire landmark, which is only one of two remaining iron trestle viaducts remaining in the UK.



Following a rope access survey, remedial works were carried out to protect the structure and repair any dangerous degradation.

The construction work was challenging, due to the structure's age and height.

To resolve this, the design and construction of a special access cradle was necessary.
