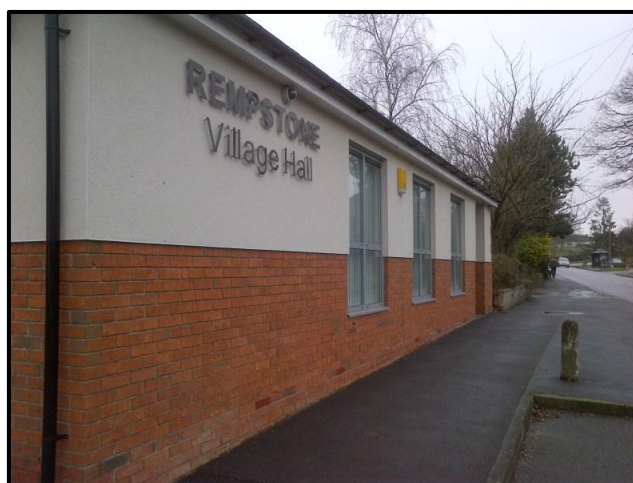
The project was the replacement of the old dilapidated timber built village hall with a new purpose facility.

GNA acted as Project Co-ordinators, Quantity Surveyors, CDM-c and Party Wall Surveyors on this project supported by Big Lottery.

GNA were instrumental in the successful application for Big Lottery funds and subsequent management of funds.

The works included the construction of a new fully fitted kitchen, a bar area and the installation of state of the art heating and air conditioning systems.

The main hall area was refurbished to accommodate 110 people complete with the inclusion of Wi-Fi and broadband facilities as well as new multi-media equipment.



Key to the project was the maximisation of the restricted and awkwardly shaped site footprint to achieve occupancy levels of over 200. Acoustic performance was also important to allow live performance without affecting neighbouring properties.

The new hall was opened on the 26<sup>th</sup> March 2011 by Kenneth Clarke MP.
