Phase 1 was the initial 22,000sqft extension of this existing warehouse and production facility followed by the phase 2, being the inclusion of a further 12,000sqft of production space, and the extensive reconfiguration of the on-site parking and access.







This project involved the early appointment of the consultant team to advance the detail design phase and allow work to commence on site as soon as planning permission was granted.

The scope of works also included detailed mechanical and electrical works including industrial process engineering, chilled water and compressed air for injection molding machines and a bespoke heat recovery system.
