This project involved extensive repair and conversion of a series of disused and derelict farm buildings into a micro-brewery and restaurant.

The buildings form part of a traditional farming estate, including a Grade II listed farm house and cottage which were renovated prior to the start of this later phase.

Within the main barn extensive restoration was undertaken, whilst the north range of barns were severely dilapidated and were dismantled and rebuilt in their previous form to modern standards.

To accommodate the equipment required for brewing beer, a contemporary steel framed barn was built alongside the existing barns

The whole estate, including the brewery and farm house has been surrounded with an extensive landscaping scheme
